One of the most engaging performers on the New England folk circuit, Howie Newman combines music, comedy and audience participation to provide a rather unique entertainment experience.

His amusing original compositions are up-tempo and catchy, and he keeps thing lively with funny between-songs banter and short comedy bits (plus a smattering of serious songs).

"I basically do the opposite of what everyone else does," says Newman. "Most singer-songwriters throw in a funny song here and there to change the pace. My serious material is a change of pace.

"It calms everyone down. For a while, anyway."

Newman's songs cover a broad range of user-friendly and often outof-the ordinary subjects, including cell phones, the music biz, baseball, marriage, intergalactic garbage collection and more.
